all file names are case sensitive
 sunset.gif ≠ Sunset.gif ≠ SUNSET.GIF

avoid spaces
 use PacificSunset.gif not Pacific Sunset.gif

use only a plain text editor to create your A1 HTML files

No software that automatically generates HTML code in any way

working at home?

- use a plain text editor to create the file
- use a web browser to view the processed pages
- get the bugs out
- take the files to campus on a floppy diskette
- transfer them to the W: drive into the `csca02' folder
- copy all relative image files and HTML
- test it thoroughly again
- print the source code (html files) when it's fixed
