- all file names are case sensitive
 - sunset.gif ≠ Sunset.gif ≠ SUNSET.GIF

- avoid spaces
 - use PacificSunset.gif not Pacific Sunset.gif

- use only a plain text editor to create your A1 HTML files
 - No software that automatically generates HTML code in any way

- working at home?
 - use a plain text editor to create the file
 - use a web browser to view the processed pages
 - get the bugs out
 - take the files to campus on a floppy diskette
 - transfer them to the W: drive into the 'csca02' folder
 - copy all relative image files and HTML
 - test it thoroughly again
 - print the source code (html files) when it's fixed
