Examine the table below that associates employees with a gender and salary. Based on the table is the following claim true or false (justify your answer)?

Every female employee earning more than 55,000 is a male.

| Employee | Gender | Salary |
| :--- | :--- | ---: |
| Al | male | 60,000 |
| Betty | female | 500 |
| Carlos | male | 40,000 |
| Doug | male | 30,000 |
| Ellen | female | 50,000 |
| Flo | female | 20,000 |

SAMPLE SOLUTION: A universally-quantified claim is false if and only if a counterexample exists. In the above claim, a counterexample would have to be a female employee earning more than 55,000 who is not male. Since examination of the table verifies that there are no female employees earning more than 55,000 , no counter-example exists, so the claim is true.

MARKING SCHEME: 1 mark for saying that a counterexample is needed to make a universally-quantified claim false, 1 mark for verifying that for the above claim has no counterexample.
