

Grammar: Parallelism

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- ▶ risks - *noun*
- ▶ lacking communication - *verb-noun*

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Projects often fail because of unrealistic goals, unmanaged risks, and poor communication.

Why Parallelism?

- ▶ Parallelism makes a sentence clearer and more elegant.
- ▶ Readers know what grammatical structure to expect.
 - ▶ Reduces the cognitive load for reading a sentence.

Identifying Faulty Parallelism

My professor was informative, lively, and a source of inspiration.

- ▶ informative - *adjective*
- ▶ lively - *adjective*
- ▶ a source of inspiration - *noun*

We need to turn the last element into an adjective

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- ▶ a source of inspiration - *noun*

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My professor was informative, lively, and inspiring.

What is wrong with the following headings of a project plan?

- ▶ scope
- ▶ stakeholders
- ▶ milestones
- ▶ managing risks

We analyze requirements of a project in order to:

- ▶ Know who are the **stakeholders**
- ▶ Elicit **requirements**
- ▶ Determine **deliverables**
